**ORDER**

Acting in accordance with La. Const. Art. V, Sec. 1 and the inherent power of this Court and considering the Public Health Emergency declared by Governor John Bel Edwards on March 11, 2020 (25 JBE 2020), supplemented on March 13, 2020 (27 JBE 2020), and further supplemented March 16, 2020 (30 JBE 2020) in response to the multiple confirmed cases of COVID-19 in the state of Louisiana; and further, in consideration of the hazardous and unsafe condition caused therefrom;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the following restrictions will be temporarily enforced until it is determined to be safe to remove them:

No admittance will be allowed into either courtroom of any person who has not been subpoenaed to appear in court on the date they are seeking admittance.

No admittance will be allowed to any person who has been in any of the following areas within the last 14 days: CHINA, JAPAN, SOUTH KOREA, EUROPE, IRAN. This list may be updated as further guidance is received.

No admittance will be allowed to any person WHO RESIDES OR HAS HAD CLOSE CONTACT WITH someone who has been in one of the above areas within the last 14 days.

No admittance will be allowed to any person who has been asked to self-quarantine by any hospital or health agency.

No admittance will be allowed to any person who suspects he/she has contracted COVID 19.

No admittance will be allowed to any person who has been diagnosed with, or has had contact with, anyone who has been diagnosed with COVID-19 or thinks they have contracted COVID-19.

The courthouse and the Clerk's office, will remain open during this period. All civil pleadings, new petitions, including new eviction proceedings, answers, or other pleadings may be

faxed to the Clerk of Court's office at (985) 646-2618 in accordance with Louisiana Revised Statute 13:850.

All matters currently set on the docket through March 27, 2020, have been continued pursuant to the Louisiana Supreme Court Order dated March 16, 2020.

If any person who is restricted from entry to a courtroom has a scheduled court appearance or is otherwise required to appear, that person should proceed as follow:


Mandatory court appearance for ALL TRAFFIC offenses is temporarily waived and may be paid in full online.
