ORDER

Acting in accordance with the Louisiana Constitution Article V, Subsection 1, and the inherent power of this Court and the Orleans Criminal District Court's Continuity of Operations Plan and considering the emergency created by the severe winter weather conditions forecasted, causing road closures and safety risk for the public and court personnel:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

The Criminal District Court for the Parish of Orleans, State of Louisiana shall be closed on Tuesday, January 28, 2014, and Wednesday, January 29, 2014, and will reopen on Thursday, January 30, 2014. Jury service for the aforementioned dates has been cancelled.

Magistrate Court schedule during emergency closure:


- There will be two (2) first appearances (**bond settings**) scheduled for Tuesday, January 28, 2014 (10:00 AM & 5:00 PM.) All second appearances scheduled for Tuesday, January 28, 2014 at 3:00 PM will be continued to Tuesday, February 4, 2014 at 3:00 PM.
- There will be two (2) first appearances (**bond settings**) scheduled for Wednesday, January 29, 2014 (10:00 AM & 5:00 PM.) All second appearances scheduled for Wednesday, January 29, 2014 at 3:00 PM will be continued to Wednesday, February 5, 2014 at 3:00 PM.

This closure shall be considered a legal holiday in accordance with LSA R.S. 1:55.

If conditions indicate that the Criminal District Court for the Parish of Orleans, State of Louisiana should remain closed beyond Wednesday, January 29, 2014, notice of the closure will be posted on the Court's website (www.criminalcourt.org), the Louisiana Supreme Court's website (www.lasc.org) and in the local media outlets.
