ORDER

On motion of, and at the request of Clerk of Court, Darlene Landry for Assumption Parish, and upon representation to the Court, that it is recommended that the office of the Assumption Parish Clerk of Court close Friday, May 20, 2016 for the entire business day due to severe weather on the evening of May 19, 2016 and because of the fact a state of emergency has been declared in Assumption Parish and there is no power to the courthouse.

IT IS ORDERED, that, pursuant to the provisions of R.S. 1:55E(2), that the Office of the Clerk of Court for the parish of Assumption be closed on Friday, May 20, 2016, for the remainder of the day. The Assumption Clerk of Court will reopen on Monday, May 23, 2016 for regular business hours. Further, pursuant to the provision of this section, the Clerk shall publish legal notice in the official parish journals advising of this closure and shall attach a statement advising of the action to every petition or pleading filed in each Clerk's Office on the first day or part of a date his/her office shall be reopened when such petition or document relates to a cause of action, right of appeal, or other matters against which prescription could have run or time periods imposed by law could have expired.


ORDER
