
O R D E R

On motion of, and at the request of the Clerks of Court for the 22nd Judicial District and upon representation to the Court, that to remain in conjunction with the offices of the Twenty-Second Judicial District Court of St. Tammany and Washington Parishes, it is recommended that the offices of the 22nd Judicial District Clerks of Court close on Thursday, January 18, 2018, due to severe winter weather.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that pursuant to the provisions of R.S. 1:55E(2), that the offices of the St. Tammany Parish Clerk of Court and the offices of the Washington Parish Clerk of Court be closed on Thursday, January 18, 2018 with said offices reopening on Friday, January 19, 2018, for regular business hours.

Further, pursuant to the provision of this section, the Clerks shall publish legal notice in the official parish journal advising of this closure and shall attach a statement advising of the action to every petition or pleading filed in the Clerk's Office on the first day his/her office shall be reopened when such petition or document relates to a cause of action, right of appeal or other matters which prescription could have run or time periods imposed by law could have expired.
