EMERGENCY CLOSURE ORDER

Acting in accordance with the Louisiana Constitution Article V, Section I, the inherent power of this Court and La R.S. 1:55(E)(2),

Whereas, St. Charles Parish experienced severe winter weather conditions on January 16, 2018 and January 17, 2018, impacting infrastructure and transportation in the Parish,

Whereas, local governing authorities anticipate that the extreme winter weather will continue to impact the area on January 18, 2018,

Whereas, during the pendency of the severe winter weather conditions, freezing conditions will cause roadways necessary for transport to and from the St. Charles Parish Courthouse to close,

Whereas, all agencies presently housed within the St. Charles Parish Courthouse will close on January 18, 2018 as a result of the severe winter weather.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the St. Charles Parish Courthouse located at 15045 River Road in Hahnville, LA 70057 shall be remain closed Thursday, January 18, 2018 and resume regular operating hours on Friday, January 19, 2018 at 7:30 a.m.

IT IS FURTHER HEREBY ORDERED that in accordance with La. R.S. 1:55(E)(2) the Clerk of Court for the Parish of St. Charles shall have published, as soon as possible, a legal notice in all of the official parish journals within the district, setting forth the dates of the closure, the hour of the closure, if applicable, the reasons for the closure, and a statement that, pursuant to La. R.S. 1:55(E)(3), these days or parts of days were legal holidays. The Clerk shall attach a similar statement to every document, petition, or pleading filed in the Office of the Clerk on the first day or part of a day his office is open after being closed under the provisions of this paragraph, whether the petition or document relates to a cause of action, right of appeal, or other
