Acting in accordance with La. Const. Article V, Subsection I and La. R.S. 1, Section 55E(2), and the inherent power of this Court, and considering the notification that the water supply for the Catahoula Parish courthouse will be cut off for repairs for the date of August 23, 2018, and considering this renders it hazardous or otherwise unsafe for employees of the Seventh Judicial District Court, Parish of Catahoula and the Catahoula Parish Clerk of Court to continue in the performance of their official duties, and for the general public to conduct business at the Parish Courthouse:


**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT** the Seventh Judicial District Court, Parish of Catahoula and the Catahoula Parish Clerk of Court's office shall be closed from 12:00 p.m. on Thursday, August 23, 2018 and will re-open on Friday, August 24, 2018 at 8:00 a.m., unless further orders are issued with respect thereto.


**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT** this closure shall be considered a legal holiday in accordance with LSA R.S. 1:55.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT** if the water supply conditions indicate that the Court and Clerk of Court's office should remain closed beyond Thursday, August 23, 2018 until the hazardous conditions subside, notice of the closure will be posted on the doors of the Clerk of Court's office and the Louisiana Supreme Court website ([www.lasc.org](http://www.lasc.org)).
