Acting in accordance with Louisiana Constitution, Article V, Section 1 and the inherent power of this Court and the *Continuity of Operations Plan* of the *East Baton Rouge Parish Juvenile Court* and considering the emergency conditions created by a winter storm predicted for *East Baton Rouge Parish* this afternoon and tomorrow, and other safety risks for the public and court staff; accordingly

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED THAT:


The Juvenile Court for the Parish of East Baton Rouge, State of Louisiana, shall close today at 1:00 p.m. and will reopen on Thursday, January 18, 2018 at 8:30 a.m.

Pursuant to Louisiana Revised Statute 1:55 and due to inclement, icy conditions predicted for East Baton Rouge Parish, creating safety risks for the public and Court staff, Wednesday, January 17, 2018 is declared a legal holiday;

Should conditions warrant, this closure order may be extended. Notice will be posted on the <http://brgov.com> website, the Louisiana Supreme Court website, www.lasc.org, and local television stations via the news media.
