ORDER OF CLOSURE

PURSUANT to the provisions of R.S. 1:55, Ranord J. Darensburg, Judicial Administrator of the Orleans Parish Juvenile Court has requested the closure of the offices of the Orleans Parish Juvenile Court for the date of Tuesday, September 4, 2018 due to an emergency situation presented by inclement weather, which in the judgment of the Judicial Administrator renders it hazardous or otherwise unsafe for employees of the Court to continue the performance of their duties or for the general public to conduct business with the Court. Under these circumstances and due to this situation, public access to Orleans Parish Juvenile Court will be dangerous and the access to records difficult.

Acting in accordance with LA. Const. Art. V., Subsection I and the inherent power of this Court, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

Due to inclement and hazardous weather conditions and the uncertainties of the extent of the impact the hazardous weather may have on the New Orleans area, the Orleans Parish Juvenile Court, Parish of Orleans, State of Louisiana and the Orleans Parish Juvenile Clerk of Court's office shall be closed on Tuesday, September 4, 2018 and will re-open on Wednesday, September 5, 2018 at 8:30a.m.

This closure shall be considered a legal holiday in accordance with LSA R.S. 1:55.
