**ORDER OF CLOSURE**

**PURSUANT** to the provisions of R.S. 1:55, Ranord J. Darenburg, Judicial Administrator of the Orleans Parish Juvenile Court has requested the closure of the offices of the Orleans Parish Juvenile Court for the date of Friday, December 14, 2018 due to an emergency situation presented by the installation of propane tank that is part of an ongoing construction project by the City of New Orleans and LANDIS Construction Company, which in the judgment of the Judicial Administrator renders it hazardous or otherwise unsafe for employees of the Court to continue the performance of their duties or for the general public to conduct business with the Court. Under these circumstances and because of this situation, public access to Orleans Parish Juvenile Court will be dangerous.

Acting in accordance with LA. Const. Art. V., Subsection I and the inherent power of this Court, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:**

Due to hazardous working conditions and the uncertainties of the extent of the impact the obstruction of the installation of a propane tank may have on the employees and public traveling to and from the building, the Orleans Parish Juvenile Court, Parish of Orleans, State of Louisiana and the Orleans Parish Juvenile Clerk of Court's office shall be closed on Friday, December 14, 2018 and will re-open on Monday, December 17, 2018 at 8:30a.m.

This closure shall be considered a legal holiday in accordance with LSA R.S. 1:55. **NEW**
