ORDER

Acting in accordance with Louisiana Constitution, Article V, Section 1 and the inherent power of this Court and the *Continuity of Operations Plan* of the *East Baton Rouge Parish Juvenile Court* and considering the emergency situation created by Hurricane Barry which is predicted to hit *East Baton Rouge Parish* on Friday, July 12, 2019 and Saturday, July 13, 2019 and other safety risks for the public and court staff:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED THAT:

The Juvenile Court for the Parish of East Baton Rouge, State of Louisiana shall be closed on Friday, July 12, 2019, and will reopen on Monday, July 15, 2019.

Pursuant to Louisiana Revised Statute 1:55 and due to inclement, flooding conditions predicted for East Baton Rouge Parish creating safety risks for the public and Court staff, Friday, July 12, 2019 is declared a legal holiday;

If conditions warrant, this closure order may be extended. Notice will be posted on the www.brla.gov website, the Louisiana Supreme Court website, www.lasc.org, and in the news media.
