ORDER OF CLOSURE

PURSUANT to the provisions of R.S. 1:55, Ranord J. Darensburg, Judicial Administrator of the Orleans Parish Juvenile Court has requested the closure of the offices of the Orleans Parish Juvenile Court for the date of Monday, September 9, 2019 because of very high temperatures and humidity levels throughout the entire Juvenile Justice Center. The rise in temperature and humidity is the result of two mal-functioning Chillers that make working and receiving services under these conditions difficult for employees to perform their jobs and the general public to conduct business with the Court. Under these circumstances and because of this situation, public access to Orleans Parish Juvenile Court will be hazardous.

Acting in accordance with LA. Const. Art. V., Subsection I and the inherent power of this Court, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:**

Because of high temperatures and humid conditions at the Juvenile Justice Center that have been mal-functioning over the past two weeks and inability to control the temperature in the building, the Orleans Parish Juvenile Court, Parish of Orleans, State of Louisiana and the Orleans Parish Juvenile Clerk of Court's office shall be closed Monday, September 9, 2019 and will re-open Tuesday, September 10, 2019 at 8:30a.m.

This closure shall be considered a legal holiday in accordance with LSA R.S. 1:55.
