4. How does the jurisdiction envision handling missing data or errors in data once an electronic data exchange is established?

5. Does the Judicial District have any other electronic data exchanges in place, today, (or planned for implementation within the next 6 months) between any of the following local agencies Sheriff, District Attorney, Clerk of Court? Please describe.
