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## **Narrative Questions**

Please provide answers to all of the following in a separate attachment to your grant application.

1. Please describe, in your own words, why your jurisdiction is best suited to receive funds for a court system upgrade. In your answer, explain whether data elements in any of the four target areas of this grant funding are already captured (mental health findings; warrants for failure to appear; charge classification for domestic violence, and defendant relationship to victim; and court-ordered firearms prohibitions). Then, provide a detailed explanation of how funding to purchase software or professionals services will produce the required data elements, whether through manual or automated processes.
2. Describe any dedicated efforts, or specialized units, in your jurisdiction that answer any of the strategic public safety concerns identified in this grant funding.
3. When any critical data errors, or omissions, are found in your case management records, how are those issues managed by the clerk of court?

## **Technical Questions:**

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1. If a part of your solution that requires funding involves integration with a sheriff's office and/or police department incident records system, name the vendor(s) for that system, and the currently installed version of the system.
2. Which vendor provides the case management system used by your jurisdiction's prosecutor's office, and which version of that vendor's system is currently installed?
3. Which vendor provides the clerk of court case management system, and what version is currently being used?
4. Does the clerk of court have a data exchange with the prosecutor's office, or are there plans to build one?
5. Does your court have a proposal on the cost to implement a data exchange with either your local law enforcement or prosecutor?
