File Description

This file will be used to temporarily store the court case information. There will be an extract record created for each offense that the defendant is charged with. This file will be created on the court's computer system in ASCII format (fixed length records with no delimiters) and then uploaded to CMIS via telephone modems.

Extract records should be generated and sent to CMIS during the following events:

- **when a case is filed**
- **when a final disposition is entered**
- **when sentencing information is entered**
- **when appeal information is entered**
- **anytime a correction is made to the case record after the sentencing info. is entered**

Except where specifically defined differently (e.g., CMSEventSequence), date information shall be placed in the extract record in the format of 'MMDDYYYY'.

Note1: The arrest tracking number will be assigned by the arresting agency. This number will be composed of 4 individual fields: **ORI**-Original Arrest Agency ID, **AFISDEV**-AFIS Device which indicates the method used to take the fingerprints, **YEAR**-Year Of Arrest, and **ARRSEQNO**-Arrest Sequence Number. The Charge Sequence number could be assigned by either the arresting agency, district attorney, or court - depending on the business practices of the District. This number composite 'arrest tracking number' will be used to distinguish the number of counts for a certain charge. Each count will be stored in a separate record.

Note2: There will be a need to standardize all charge codes. A lookup window should be provided by the software to assist the user in determining which charge code to use. (It is preferable that any local statutes be converted to State Statutes)

Note3: The final dispositon code will also be a standardized list of codes. Ex) D-Dismissed, G - Guilty, NG - Not Guilty, PG - Pled Guilty, NP - Nolle Pros, M - Mistrial, etc.

Note4: If the Arrest Tracking Number has not been provided by the arresting agency and/or DA, a Charge Sequence Number must be generated for each individual charge that pertains to a Docket Number. For example, if the individual had three different charges filed under one case (docket), the 1st charge record would contain a Charge Sequence Number of '001' the next record would be assigned '002' and the 3rd record '003'.

Note5: If a record is to be sealed, a "S" must be placed in the Seal-Rec field. If the record is to be expunged, a "X" must be placed in the Seal-Rec field. The original disposition code is not to be changed. **When "X" is entered in the Seal-Rec field, the Art 893/894 field must be populated with either a '1' or a '2' value, where 1=893 felony expungement, and 2=894 misdemeanor expungement.**

24 - Principal
25 - Accessory After The Fact (RS 14:25)
26 - Criminal Conspiracy (RS 14:26)
27 - Attempt (RS 14:27)
79 - Attempt and Conspiracy - Drugs (RS 40:979)

Can enter up to 2 digits. Do not place a decimal in this field. If the BAC is 0.120, then the correct entry would be 12.

Note10: As of January 2001, when the Final Disposition is entered, the Conviction Charge field must also be populated. If there is a charge modifier, the CC-Modifier field must also be populated. This field was formally known as the ALTERNATE-CHARGE field.

Note11: The total length of sentence, which is entered in the SLEN-YRS, SLEN-MOS, SLEN-DAYS fields should be a total of the days captured in the JAIL-CONSECUTIVE-DAYS and JAIL-DAYS-IN-LIEU-OF-FINE fields.

Note12: All XML tags MUST be entered as seen in column. The Arrest Tracking # is a composite of 4 to 5 fields; therefore no XML tag is needed for this item as well as the Sentence Type and the Probation Requirement.

Note 14: The CMIS ID field is to be a unique identifier issued to each record when it is created. When the record is altered, the same id should be sent back with the altered record for identification puposes.

Note 15: The last record in the file will contain information to indicate the total number of records in the file. For ASCII files, the first 5 positions of this record, which are the Parish ID and Court ID, will contain 5 asterisks '*****' followed by 2 blank spaces in the Court Section field. The Docket Number field will contain the record count. The example below indicates that the file contains 100 records:

***** 100

For XML files, the Parish and Court ID fields will contain 2 and 3 astericks respectively. The Docket Number field will contain the record count.

Note 18: Under R.S. 13:753 AS(5), this field is set to Y-Yes when the defendant has been placed on probation pursuant to C.Cr.P. Article 895 A(6) and the judge imposed as a condition of probation that the defendant is prohibited from possessing or purchasing a firearm during the period of probation. If this field is set to Y-Yes, then the following existing CMIS reportable fields are required:

- 1. Probation Type - (PROB-TYPE)
- 2. Length of Probation with a valid value in either the PROB-YRS and/or PROB-MOS fields
- 3. Disposition - (FINAL-DISPO)
- 4. Disposition Charge - (CONVICTION-CHARGE)
- 5. Disposition Date - (FDDATE)

Note 19: This field is set to Y-Yes when the Judge issued an order prohibiting the defendant from possessing or purchasing a firearm pursuant to LA R.S. 13:753 A(5). If this field is set to Y-Yes, then the following existing CMIS reportable fields are required:

- 1. Disposition - (FINAL-DISPO)
- 2. Disposition Charge - (CONVICTION-CHARGE)
- 3. Disposition Date - (FDDATE)

Note 20: The SID field must be right justified. (8-29-2014: Size of SID field increased in the CMIS database from 9 to 15 characters for future growth)

Note 21: As of 2015, Warrant disposition codes will now be sent to CMIS for distribution to other criminal justice agencies. Disposition date is also required when any of the warrant values are supplied by the court

- Note 22: NICS relationship to victim values:
- This field should not be displayed on public terminals or documents!**
- ' 01=Current or former spouse of victim (can be same sex)
 - ' 02=Parent/step-parent of victim
 - ' 03=Guardian of victim
 - 04=Child in common with victim (biological child - must be born)
 - ' 05=Current or former intimate cohabitant (can be same sex) of victim
 - ' 06=Defendant is cohabitating or has cohabitated as parent of victim
 - ' 07=Person is cohabiting or has cohabited as guardian
 - ' 08=Person similarly situated to spouse (can be same sex)
 - ' 09=Person similarly situated to parent
