- ORDER OF COURT -



- ORDER OF COURT -


In accordance with applicable laws, in such cases made and provided, and considering that the hurricane named "Gustav" struck the Louisiana coast on or about September 2, 2008; and

Considering that the Parish of Terrebonne, through its Parish President, has declared a state of emergency by the recordation of said Proclamation, under entry number 1305210 of the records of the Parish of Terrebonne, Louisiana; and

Considering that the restoration of electrical power in the Parish of Terrebonne is not known, and further considering the personnel involved in the operation of the Courts, including the Office of the Clerk of Court, should be released from duties in order to tend to their families, homes and properties, all in order to minimize the effects of the damage incurred as a result of this hurricane.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED That this Court, through Chief Judge George J. Larke, Jr., does hereby Order, direct and approve the closing of all Court operations, effective Thursday, September 4, 2008, through and including Friday, September 12, 2008. All Court operations are tentatively scheduled to re-open on Monday, September 15, 2008.
