ORDER


Acting in accordance with La. Const. Art. V, Sec. 1, the inherent power of this Court, and the Declaration of Emergency declared by Mayor C. Ray Nagin in consideration of the threat of Hurricane Gustav;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED THAT:

The Civil District Court for the Parish of Orleans, First and Second City Courts, the Offices of the Clerks of the Courts, Civil Sheriff, Constable, Mortgage & Conveyance, and Notarial Archives, will be closed from Friday, August 29, 2008 at 5:00 through and including Wednesday, September 3, 2008. If no further Orders issue, all offices will reopen on Thursday, September 4, 2008. A Duty Judge is available to handle all emergency matters.
