

SUPREME COURT OF LOUISIANA

ORDER

Acting in accordance with Article V, Sections 1 and 5 of the Louisiana Constitution of 1974, Title XXXIII of the Louisiana Code of Criminal Procedure, Articles 941, *et seq.*, and considering the emergency caused by Hurricane Gustav, Executive Proclamation No. 51 BJ 2008 and a communication received by this Court from Orleans Parish Criminal District Court Chief Judge Arthur Hunter,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED THAT:

**Part 1.**

The Orleans Parish Criminal District Court shall be authorized to hold emergency sessions of court beginning on Sunday, August 31, 2008 at the following locations:

Ninth Judicial District Court  
701 Murray St  
Alexandria, LA 71301

Alexander Fulton Hotel  
701 4<sup>th</sup> St.  
Alexandria, LA 71301


In accordance with C.Cr.P. Art. 947, the Orleans Parish Criminal District Court shall retain all authority and powers previously exercised by it in Orleans Parish. This order shall not deprive the judges of Orleans Parish Criminal District Court, of their offices as judge of the Orleans Parish Criminal District Court, nor shall it deprive any judge of the Ninth Judicial District Court, Parish of Rapides of his or her office as judge of the Ninth Judicial District Court, Parish of Rapides.

**Part 2.**

Pursuant to C.Cr.P. Art. 955, the time periods, limitations, and delays in all criminal proceedings, established by the provisions of the Code of Criminal Procedure, Children's Code, Title 15, and Chapter 26 of Title 40 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950 shall be suspended in Orleans Parish for ninety (90) days commencing on August 31, 2008, unless further extended or shortened, by order of this Court.


