

AMENDED EMERGENCY CLOSURE ORDER


Doug Welborn, acting in his capacity as Clerk of Court for the East Baton Rouge Parish Nineteenth Judicial District Court, having determined that the severe weather conditions on Tuesday, August 28, 2012 from 12:00 p.m. through Thursday, August 30, 2012 have created an emergency situation in East Baton Rouge Parish which renders it hazardous and unsafe for employees of the office of the East Baton Rouge Parish Clerk of Court to perform their official duties and for the general public to conduct business with the East Baton Rouge Parish Clerk of Court's Office, requested approval pursuant to La. R.S. 1:55(E)(2) to close the offices of the East Baton Rouge Parish Clerk of Court on Tuesday, August 28, 2012 from 12:00 p.m. through Thursday, August 30, 2012;

IT IS HEREBY DECREED that the East Baton Rouge Parish Clerk of Court is authorized to close his offices at 12:00 p.m. on Tuesday, August 28, 2012 through Thursday, August 30, 2012;

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the Nineteenth Judicial District Court shall be closed at 12:00 p.m. on Tuesday, August 28, 2012 through Thursday, August 30, 2012;

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that in accordance with La. R.S. 1:55(E)(2) the East Baton Rouge Parish Clerk of Court shall publish in the official journal for East Baton Rouge Parish notice of this Order and a statement that pursuant to La. R.S. 1:55(E)(2), Tuesday, August 28, 2012 was declared a half holiday and Wednesday, August 29, 2012 and Thursday, August 30, 2012 were declared legal holidays for the Nineteenth Judicial District Court.
