ORDER


On motion of, and at the request of, Tom Sullivan, Clerk of this Court, and upon representation to the Court that due to the approach of Hurricane Isaac, and its potential hazard to his employees, creating an emergency situation, he requests closure of his office, for the entire business day of Tuesday, August 28 and Wednesday, August 29, 2012:

IT IS ORDERED, that, pursuant to the provisions of R.S. 1:55 E(2) that the Office of the Clerk of Court for the Parish of Livingston be closed for the entire business days on Tuesday, August 28, and Wednesday, August 29, 2012. Further, pursuant to the provisions of that section, the Clerk shall publish a legal notice in the official parish journal advising of this closure and shall attach a statement advising of the action to every petition or pleading filed in the Office of the Clerk of Court on the first day or part of a date his office shall be reopened when such petition or document relates to a cause of action, right of appeal, or other matter against which prescription could have run or time periods imposed by law could have expired.
