IN RE: CLOSURE OF JEFFERSON PARISH JUVENILE COURT

ORDER

Acting in accordance with Louisiana Constitution, Article V, Section 1 and the inherent power of this Court and considering the emergency situation created by Hurricane Isaac,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED THAT:

Acting in accordance with the Jefferson Parish Juvenile Court's (hereinafter, "the Court") Continuity of Operations Plan, the Court shall extend its previous order and continue to be closed through Friday, August 31, 2012, and reopen Tuesday, September 4, 2012, which is the day after Labor Day, Monday, September 3, 2012;

Pursuant to Louisiana Revised Statute 1:55 and due to potential hazardous weather and the uncertain aftermath resulting from Hurricane Isaac, Thursday, August 30, and Friday, August 31, 2012 are declared legal holidays in addition to August 27, 28, and 29, 2012 which were declared in the prior order of this court;

If conditions warrant, this closure order may be extended. Notice will be posted on the Court's website, www.jpjc.org, the Louisiana Supreme Court website, www.lasc.org, and in the newsmedia.
