ORDER

Acting in accordance with Louisiana Constitution, Article V, Section 1 and the inherent power of this Court and considering the emergency situation created by Hurricane Isaac,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED THAT:

Acting in accordance with the Jefferson Parish Juvenile Court's (hereinafter, "the Court") Continuity of Operations Plan, the Court shall extend its previous order and continue to be closed through Tuesday, September 4, 2012, and will reopen Wednesday, September 5, 2012;

Pursuant to Louisiana Revised Statute 1:55 and due to potential hazardous weather and the uncertain aftermath resulting from Hurricane Isaac, Tuesday, September 4, 2012 is declared a legal holiday in addition to August 27, 28, 29, 30, and 31, 2012 which were declared in the prior orders of this court;

If conditions warrant, this closure order may be extended. Notice will be posted on the Court's website, www.jpjc.org, the Louisiana Supreme Court website, www.lasc.org, and in the newsmedia.
