**ORDER**

Acting under the authority of Article V, Section 1 of Constitution of 1974, and the inherent power of this Court, and considering the uncertainties of the extent of the impact Tropical Storm Isaac may have on our area,

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

The Louisiana Supreme Court will be closed starting Monday, August 27, 2012 and will reopen on Thursday, August 30, 2012. This closure is considered a legal holiday in accordance with LSA R.S. 1:55. All filings due during the period of closure (August 27, 2012 through August 29, 2012) shall be deemed timely filed if filed on Thursday, August 30, 2012. Parties who are unable to file within this extended time period may submit motions requesting a further extension of time to file with supporting documentation and argument.

If conditions indicate that the Court should remain closed beyond August 29, 2012, notice of the closure will be posted on the Court's website at [www.lasc.org](http://www.lasc.org), and in the news media.
