

SUPREME COURT OF LOUISIANA

**EMERGENCY ORDER CONCERNING NEW LAWYERS
ADMITTED TO THE PRACTICE OF LAW IN 2004**

Acting in accordance with Article V, Sections 1 and 5 of the 1974 Louisiana Constitution, and the inherent power of this Court, and considering the hardships imposed on Louisiana-licensed lawyers by Hurricanes Katrina and Rita, as well as the recommendation of the Mandatory Continuing Legal Education Committee,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED THAT:

Any attorney who was admitted to the practice of law in Louisiana in calendar year 2004 shall be allowed until the end of calendar year 2006 to fulfill the CLE requirements contained in La. S. Ct. Rule XXX, Rule 3(b). No other CLE requirements shall be imposed upon 2004 admittees in calendar year 2006.
