Emergency Rule Concerning Changes in the Deadline for the Law Student Registration Program

Acting in accordance with Article V, Sections 1 and 5 of the 1974 Louisiana Constitution, and the inherent power of this Court, and considering the need to provide a temporary extension of the deadline for participation in the Law Student Registration Program administered by the National Conference of Bar Examiners,

It is hereby ordered, adjudged, and decreed that:

Louisiana Supreme Court Rule XVII, Section 4(A) be and is hereby temporarily amended so as to allow prospective applicants for admission to the Bar of this state to submit an application to the National Conference of Bar Examiners and pay the prescribed fee no later than February 1st of the spring semester of the second academic year of law school.

This emergency rule shall be effective until June 30, 2006, until amended or changed through further Order of this Court.
