Emergency Rule Concerning Changes in the Deadline for Consideration of Applications for Equivalency Determinations

Acting in accordance with Article V, Sections 1 and 5 of the 1974 Louisiana Constitution, and the inherent power of this Court, and considering the need to provide a temporary extension of the deadline for consideration of pending applications for equivalency determinations,

It is hereby ordered, adjudged, and decreed that:

Louisiana Supreme Court Rule XVII, Section 6(C), fifth paragraph, second sentence, be and is hereby temporarily amended so as to allow the Equivalency Determination Panel to consider and act upon pending equivalency applications for the February 2006 bar examination no later than November 15, 2005.

This emergency rule shall be effective until June 30, 2006, until amended or changed through further Order of this Court.
