Event Info: **Law Day Exhibit – “Abraham Lincoln: A Legacy of Liberty”**

In celebration of Law Day 2009, the Law Library of Louisiana will introduce an exhibit commemorating the bicentennial of Abraham Lincoln’s birth. The exhibit, created by Jason Kruppa of the Law Library staff, features four exhibit cases:

- Lincoln as Lawyer, which highlights Lincoln’s 24-year career as a prairie attorney
- Lincoln as Statesman, featuring his writings both as a legislator and as president
- Lincoln in Popular Culture, including movies, money and, best of all, Lincoln logs (with a log cabin)
- Lincoln in Books, with a few prime examples from the over 4,000 books written about Lincoln since his death

The exhibit is currently on display at the Law Library of Louisiana on the second floor of the Louisiana Supreme Courthouse 400 Royal Street, New Orleans, LA.
