IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of Court transmit certified copies of Mr. Bynum’s pleadings to the District Attorney for the Parish of Orleans, State of Louisiana, for investigation of whether Mr. Bynum’s conduct violates La. R.S. 37:213, and to the Unlicensed Practice of Law Committee of The Florida Bar for its consideration.
