## PER CURIAM

The application for rehearing is granted for the sole purpose of correcting this court's opinion of April 3, 2001 to read as follows:

In an unrelated matter, Clem Mitchell retained respondent to represent him in a criminal case, as well as related civil service and worker's compensation proceedings. Mr. Mitchell paid respondent \$7,000 for the full representation in November, 1996. Respondent performed minimal work on behalf of Mr. Mitchell. Approximately fourteen months later, Mr. Mitchell discharged respondent and requested an accounting and return of the unearned fee. Respondent failed to comply with either request, alleging he earned the entire fee.

In all other respects, the application for rehearing is denied.
