PER CURIAM

After reviewing the evidence and considering the law, we conclude petitioner, Joseph A. Should petitioner commit any misconduct during the period of probation, his conditional right to practice may be terminated or he may be subjected to other discipline pursuant to the Rules for Lawyer Disciplinary Enforcement.
