WRIT GRANTED. Petitioner presented a post-conviction claim of ineffective assistance of counsel regarding the imposition of an illegal sentence following his guilty plea for Indecent Behavior with Juveniles, in violation of La. R.S. 14:81. The claim was dismissed on procedural grounds as time barred. We grant the writ application and remand the case to the district court to be considered as a motion to correct an illegal sentence, which, if meritorious, is an exception to the time limitations for post-conviction applications. *See* La. C.Cr.P. art. 882.
