JOHNSON, C.J., would grant the writ application. I find this tort action against a physical therapist is not governed by the Medical Malpractice Act. I would allow Plaintiffs' expert physical therapist to testify. Finding genuine issues of material fact remain, I would grant the writ application and reverse the rulings of the lower courts and deny the motion for summary judgment.
