Law filed by Danny Wayne Sylvester, Jr., Louisiana Bar Roll number 24228, and the
concurrence thereto filed by the ODC,
IT IS ORDERED that the request of Danny Wayne Sylvester, Jr. for permanent
resignation in lieu of discipline be and is hereby granted, pursuant to Supreme Court Rule
XIX, § 20.1 and Rule 5.5 of the Rules of Professional Conduct.
IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Danny Wayne Sylvester, Jr. shall be
permanently prohibited from practicing law in Louisiana or in any other jurisdiction in
which he is admitted to the practice of law; shall be permanently prohibited from seeking
readmission to the practice of law in this state or in any other jurisdiction in which he is
admitted; and shall be permanently prohibited from seeking admission to the practice of
law in any jurisdiction.
