Louisiana, 577 U.S, 136 S.Ct. 718, 193 L.Ed.2d 599 (2016) that Miller v.
Alabama, 567 U.S, 132 S.Ct. 2455, 183 L.Ed.2d 407 (2012) announced a
substantive rule of constitutional law that applies retroactively, we vacate relator's
sentence and remand this case to the 15th Judicial District Court for further
proceedings consistent with the views expressed in State v. Montgomery, 13-1163
(La. 6/28/16), 194 So.3d 606, and for resentencing pursuant to La.C.Cr.P. art.
878.1.
