Writ Granted. Respondent has exhausted his right to state collateral review and his claim raised herein is time barred as a matter of La. C.Cr.P. art. 930.8. See State ex rel. Joel Orellana v. State of Louisiana, 20161610 (La. 1/12/18), __ So.3d __, 2018 WL 459744. Therefore, the judgment of the court of appeal ordering the district court to provide Respondent with a copy of his Boykin transcript free of charge is reversed. See State ex rel. Brown v. State of Louisiana, 2003-2568 (La. 3/26/04), 870 So.2d 976. Additionally, La. C.Cr.P. art. 930.4 bars the filing of successive post-conviction applications unless respondent can show an exception applies.
