**ON SUPERVISORY WRITS TO THE TWENTY-FOURTH
DISTRICT COURT, PARISH OF JEFFERSON**

PER CURIAM:

Writ granted in part; otherwise denied. We grant the defendant's application to modify the first condition under which the district court authorized testimony by simultaneous broadcast as follows: "that the witness can see *the defendant* and the person who is questioning *the witness* after that person identifies himself, and that *the defendant* and the opposing attorney and trier of fact can see the witness and his responses at all times." While we modify the district court's ruling in this manner, we offer no opinion now without benefit of a full appellate record as to whether the procedure authorized by the district court will ultimately violate the Confrontation Clause.
