The City of Baton Rouge and Parish of East Baton Rouge appeal directly to this court pursuant to La. Const. Art. V, §5(D) from a ruling of the district court declaring La. R.S. 13:5105(C), La. R.S. 13:5105(D) and City/Parish Resolution 36859 unconstitutional.

For the reasons assigned in <u>Kimball v. Allstate Ins. Co.</u>, 97-2885 c/w 97-2956 (La. 4/14/98), ____ So. 2d ____, the judgment of the district court declaring La. R.S. 13:5105(C) unconstitutional is affirmed. The judgment of the district court declaring La. R.S. 13:5105(D) and City/Parish Resolution 36859 unconstitutional is reversed, and the case is remanded to the district court for further proceedings.
