Juvenile proceedings shall not be randomly allotted to a particular division by the Clerk of Court. The District Attorney shall be responsible for docketing juvenile cases. However, each case shall remain in the division of first appearance. Additionally, every effort shall be made to keep matters involving members of the same family with the same division.

The District Attorney shall be responsible for the docketing of Title IV-D Social Security Act cases. The same shall be heard in whichever division is in criminal session.

**Rule No:** 41.2

Court Procedures

For all hearings and non-jury trials, unless excepted herein or the necessity for which has been specifically waived by the judge, comprehensive pre-hearing and pre-trial briefs shall be filed with the judge not later than seven days prior to the hearing or trial. The filing of a brief in the suit record shall not be permitted.

The provisions of this section shall not apply to criminal cases, uncontested matters, rule to show cause in separation and divorce cases, juvenile court and adoption matters.
