RULE XXVIII. CRIMINAL COURT CALENDAR

Section 1. Except for those weeks designated as criminal jury trial weeks in Title III, Appendix 11 of these Rules and on weeks commencing on a fifth Monday, the division of Court sitting in criminal session shall adhere generally to the following schedule during the Regular Term of Court: Mondays -- Criminal Motions; Tuesdays -- Misdemeanor and Felony Arraignments; Wednesdays -- Misdemeanor Trials; Thursdays -- (1st) Administrative Day/Approval of Pleas, (2nd, 3rd & 45th) -- Criminal Motions; Fridays -- (1st) Administrative Day/Plea Approval Deadline, (2nd) Entry of Felony Bench Trials/Criminal Motions. The Court in the interest of justice and as docket need may dictate may also schedule any non jury criminal matter for any available legal day.

RULE XXXI. PLACEMENT AND REVIEW OF CHILDREN IN FOSTER CARE

Effective January 1,
1997.

Section 1. It shall be the policy of this Court that when the State of Louisiana has been granted custody of a child(ren), and that child(ren) is/are placed in foster care, this Court shall immediately implement the procedures required by the Louisiana Children's Code and other applicable federal and state law.

Section 2. This Court shall periodically review the cases of all children in foster care to ensure it is in the best interest of each child that he/she remain in foster care, or be returned to his/her home, or parental rights be terminated as the best interest of the child may dictate.

Section 3. This Court shall observe the federal and state guidelines in connection with the review of said child in foster care; and therefore a permanent plan for each child shall be developed.
