RULE 8. STATUS AND PRETRIAL CONFERENCES

Section A. Any party who desires a date for trial on the merits shall request a status conference before requesting a trial date in all cases except successions, collection cases, domestic matters (except partitions), and uncontested matters. Exceptions to this rule may be made by the individual judges depending on the nature or seriousness of the case. Pretrial conferences may be scheduled at the discretion of the judge.

RULE 10. DOMESTIC MATTERS

Parties/counsel in domestic matters involving support shall exchange all pertinent financial information at least forty-eight (48) hours (exclusive of weekends and holidays) prior to hearing.

Counsel shall confer at least forty-eight (48) hours (exclusive of weekends and holidays) in advance of any contradictory hearing or trial in reference to child support, alimony, or partition of community property for the purpose of attempting to amicably resolve the dispute scheduled for hearing.
