Pursuant to La.Rev.Stat. 9:302 the court may in those instances where good cause is shown and provided that there is mutual consent of all parties, civil hearings and divorce proceedings before the trial court may be held in chambers. Such hearings shall include contested and uncontested proceedings and rules for spousal support, child support, visitation, injunctions, and other matters provisional and incidental to divorce proceedings. A motion for hearing in chamber pursuant to this rule may be made by either party or upon the court=s own motion.
