IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the OBLIGOR shall advise the court and the obligee of any change in his employment during the effective period of assignment and shall advise the court and the obligee of the name and address of any new employer. The PAYOR shall inform the OBLIGEE in writing within ten days when the OBLIGOR terminates employment, and shall provide the OBLIGOR's last known address and the name and address of the OBLIGOR's new employer, if known.

The court also has the discretion to assess and collect fees not to exceed five (5%) percent of the total support obligation pursuant to said statute.
