Each party shall update and file their detailed descriptive list at least thirty (30) days prior to a partition trial on the merits, but in no event shall the update be prepared and filed more than sixty (60) days prior to trial.

RULE VII

Subject to rules of court all rules, trials, motions and exceptions shall be heard on rule days, provided, however, any rule or trial requiring extended testimony may be scheduled by the court on any other civil day in the discretion of the court.

B. All parties seeking partition of community property shall file a sworn detailed descriptive list of all community property with the fair market value and location of each asset, and all community liabilities. The list shall indicate whether community ownership of the property is disputed or undisputed or if community liabilities are disputed.

The opposing party who files a traverse of the sworn descriptive list of the community property shall list all items of community property and shall follow the same format, listing value and location of each asset and shall indicate whether he or she concurs with or traverses that item.
