St. Tammany and Washington Parishes	<p>In Child Support Enforcement Proceedings (Title IV-D, Non-Support), the Court shall assess, as authorized by law, an additional five percent (5%) to each support obligation, including existing arrearages, as well as ongoing support payments.</p> <p>All parties in all Child Support Enforcement (Title IV-D, Non-Support) cases are responsible for notifying the Court in writing through the Regional Support Enforcement Services Office of any change of address or place of employment.</p>

Title IV–D AFDC and non–AFDC (Social Security Act) cases are generally handled by the Jefferson Parish District Attorney by contract or the Regional Office of the La. Dept. of Social Services through the Jefferson Parish Juvenile Court.</p> <p>B. Any written stipulation or judgment involving child support shall conform with La. R.S. 9:313. Any judgment of child support shall also be accompanied by the State Registry Data Form.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">AFDC PATERNITY SUITS</p> <p>Title IV-D AFDC paternity suits are generally handled by the Jefferson Parish District Attorney’s Office by contract or the Regional Office of the Department of Social Services in the Jefferson Parish Juvenile Court.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">CRIMINAL NON-SUPPORT</p> <p>Criminal non-support matters are generally handled through the Jefferson Parish District Attorney’s Office in Jefferson Parish Juvenile Court.</p>
