Any party may take exception to a Hearing Officer’s findings of fact or law and move for a contradictory hearing before the Judge to whom the case has been allotted.</p> <p>B. A written opposition to the Hearing Officer’s recommendation shall be filed within five (5) days, exclusive of legal holidays, from the issuance of the recommendation.</p> <p>C. Upon the filing of a motion for contradictory hearing, the court shall schedule a hearing on the court’s next available date at which time the Judge shall accept, reject or modify, in whole or in part, the findings of the Hearing Officer.</p> <p>D. Except in extraordinary circumstances, if no exception is filed within five (5) days following the issuance of the initial recommendation, an order shall be signed by the Judge. Said judgment shall be final and appealable to the proper appellate court.</p>

Art. 2785 et seq. shall be set on the docket of the domestic commissioner pursuant to Appendix 32.0B.
