15 th J.D.C.	Acadia, Lafayette, and Vermilion Parishes Amended October 30, 2015, effective October 1, 2015.	If a written objection to the Hearing Officer recommendation is timely filed by either party, then the Hearing Officer recommendation shall be forwarded to the District Judge who may accept, reject, or modify it in whole or in part as a temporary order after the objection period has expired until a contradictory hearing can be had. Any such temporary order signed by the District Judge shall be considered interlocutory in nature.
22 nd JDC	St. Tammany and Washington Parishes	<i>See</i> Appendix 32.0B for the 22 nd Judicial District Court, Rules on Hearing Officers and Domestic Commissioners.
24 th JDC	Jefferson Parish	Prior to a consent between the parties or a judicial determination of the merits of the support demand, the recommendation of the hearing officer shall be signed by the district court judge and shall be deemed an interim order for support, without prejudice to either party.
