**ORDER**

Acting in accordance with Article V, Sections 1 and 5 of the 1974 Louisiana Constitution, Rule XXXIII of the Rules of this Court, and the inherent power of this Court, and considering the need to amend the reassignment rule in the Twenty-First Judicial District Court,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED THAT:

Part G, Section 12D of the Supreme Court General Administrative Rules be and is hereby amended to read as follows:

**D. Reassignment of Cases in the 21<sup>st</sup> Judicial District Court**

In the event the 21<sup>st</sup> Judicial District Court establishes one juvenile division of court in accordance with Rule XXXIII of the Rules of this Court, 50% of the civil cases which are allotted to the juvenile division, and all of the adult criminal arraignments and adult misdemeanor cases which are allotted to the juvenile division, may be randomly reassigned to the non-juvenile divisions of court.

This rule change shall become effective on July 1, 2004 and shall remain in full force and effect thereafter, until amended through future orders of this Court.
