

SUPREME COURT OF LOUISIANA

ORDER

Acting in accordance with Article V, Sections 1 and 5 of the 1974 Louisiana Constitution, and the inherent power of this Court, and considering the need to amend the Rules for Continuing Legal Education,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED THAT:

Louisiana Supreme Court Rule XXX, Regulation 5.1(a)(2) be and is amended to read as follows:

Regulation 5.1 (a)

* * *

(2) If the Preliminary Transcript is accurate and the Member qualifies for an exemption under Rule 2, that Member must claim the appropriate exemption with the MCLE Committee by returning the transcript no later than January 31 of the following calendar year. The Member must qualify for and claim an exemption annually for each year that the exemption is applicable to their MCLE status.

This rule change shall become effective upon signing and shall remain in full force and effect thereafter, until amended or changed through future Orders of this Court.
