**ORDER**

Acting in accordance with Article V, Sections 1 and 5 of the Louisiana Constitution of 1974, and the inherent power of this Court, and considering the need to amend the Rules for Continuing Legal Education,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED THAT:

Louisiana Supreme Court Rule XXX, Rule 5(c) be and is hereby deleted in its entirety and amended to read as follows:

**RULE XXX. RULES FOR CONTINUING LEGAL EDUCATION**

**RULE 5. ANNUAL REPORT**

\* \* \* \* \*

(c) On or before March 15 the MCLE Committee will forward to each non-complying Member a final transcript of compliance for the preceding calendar year. Such members shall correct any error(s) in the final transcript by forwarding to the MCLE Committee a written explanation of any such error(s) by March 31<sup>st</sup>. Members whose transcripts reflect compliance with the MCLE requirements of this Rule shall not receive a copy of their final transcript, but shall receive email notification reflecting such compliance.

This rule change shall become effective upon signing, and shall remain in full force and effect thereafter, until amended or changed through future orders of this Court.
