La. R.S. 1:55(E)2


Upon Oral Motion of the Clerk of Court and upon consideration of public health recommendations for the COVID-19 virus

The order of this court dated and rendered March 19, 2020 ordering the closure of the St. Mary Parish Clerk's office is hereby amended as follows;


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the St. Mary Parish Clerk of Court shall reopen and reduce its hours of operation due to the COVID-19 virus pandemic and to reduce risk of exposure to the public and the office staff during this health emergency. Any exposure would place staff at risk of getting the virus which would prevent our office from performing their duties and the public for conducting business with the Clerk of Court.

The St. Mary Parish Clerk of Court is ordered to reopen and reduce their hours of operation to 8:30am to 1:00 pm beginning March 24, 2020 and continue until further orders of the Court.
