EMERGENCY ORDER RELATIVE TO COVID-19 PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY

O R D E R

In light of the COVID-19 public health emergency, the state of emergency declaration issued by Governor John Bel Edwards on March 22, 2020, the recommendations issued on March 12, 2020 by the Louisiana Supreme Court and extended on March 20, 2020, the 36th Judicial District Court and Beauregard Parish Clerk of Court issue the following Order for the Parish of Beauregard:

In consideration of the public health recommendations to reduce the risk of exposure to the virus and slowing the spread of the disease while balancing the need to maintain access to the Louisiana court system of Beauregard Parish,

The 36th Judicial District Court and the Beauregard Parish Clerk of Court will be open to the public, according to precautions as explained at the entrance, from 8:30 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, commencing Tuesday, March 24, 2020, through April 13, 2020. The Court will continue to hear emergency and/or time sensitive matters in criminal and civil cases via SKYPE and teleconferencing as determined by each judicial division, some of which may occur at times when the building is closed.
